Disciplines and Categories:

Cadets under 13 yrs (U13) female and male fighters in separate categories in semi-contact and under 16 yrs (U16) (point-stop fighting); categories by body size (in cms)
125, -135, -145, -155, -165, -175, +175 cms

Juniors under 19 yrs (U19) men's semi- & light-contact (point-stop & continuous fighting)
-57/ -63/ -69/ -74/ -79/ -84/ -89/ -94/ +94 kgs
women's semi- & light-contact (point-stop & continuous fighting)
-50/ -55/ -60/ -65/ +65 kgs

Adults men's semi- & light-contact (point-stop & continuous fighting)
-57/ -63/ -69/ -74/ -79/ -84/ -89/ -94/ +94 kgs
women's semi- & light-contact (point-stop & continuous fighting)
-50/ -55/ -60/ -65/ -70/ +70 kgs

Newcomers (adult category) men's **newcomer** full-contact & lowkick
-57/-60/ -63,5/ -67/ -71/ -75/ -81/ -86/ -91/ +91 kgs
women's **newcomer** full-contact & lowkick
-52/ -56/ -60/ -65/ -70/ +70 kgs

Categories: participating fighters in the newcomer categories in two divisions: 0 - 5 fights & 6 -10 fights 5 fights in light-contact (continuous fighting) will be counted as 1 full-contact fight in the ring!

Veterans men & women in semi- & light-contact (point-stop & continuous fighting)
-60/+60 kgs (women) & -80/+80 kgs (men)

Team Fight 4 fighters (3 men + 1 woman)

The organizers reserve the right to change/combine/cancel weight categories due to an insufficient number of registered fighters. Time schedule and fighting times also subject to change.

Rules of Participation: Members with a valid ÖBFK- or WAKO-fighters passport with annual stamp/sticker for 2009. Valid annual medical examination stamp (not older than 1 year!) and **letter of permission from parents/legal guardian** (for all fighter's under 18 yrs of age) must be presented. Fighters without valid fighter's passport or annual stamp/sticker must show their order forms for the latter plus confirmation of payment at the registration.
The annual medical examination stamp is mandatory.

Age Categories:

Adults from the 18th birthday
Juniors U19 from the 16th birthday until 1 day before the 19th birthday
Cadets U16 from the 13th birthday until 1 day before the 16th birthday
Cadets U13 from the 08th birthday until 1 day before the 13th birthday
Veterans from the 40th birthday

Age Regulation Fighters in full-contact & lowkick over 36 yrs, in light-contact (continuous fighting) over 38 yrs, and in semi-contact (point-stop fighting) over 40 yrs of age have to show a symptom-limited full-range ergometric examination report including ECG and blood-pressure monitoring (RR).

Preliminaries 2 rounds with 2 min. gross time, 1 min. break
Finals 3 rounds with 2 min. gross time, 1 min. break

Cadets U13 & U16

Preliminaries & Finals 2 rounds with 1:30 min. gross time, 1 min. break

starting fee per discipline € 20.- , or € 15.- with pre-registration
multiple starts possible
